WHERE THE MONEY WENT

TOTAL \$52,000

THE PET MOB: is PETstock Assist's very own Indigenous Health Program. Our team volunteer their time and travel to Papunya in the Northern Territory to perform much needed desexing and vaccinations. We know that through animal health we can better the health of Indigenous Australians. In 2018/19 not only did we set up our own program, but we also supported other programs working in the same space. A total of \$52,000 was donated to this area of work.

GUIDE DOGS: PETstock stores and team members support Guide Dogs Australia annually through in-store fundraising and activations. We have a long-standing relationship with Guide Dogs Australia and believe in the services they provide to those living with low vision. In 2018/19 we donated over \$50,000.

TEAM GIVING DONATIONS: The charities who benefit from these donations are selected by our PETstock team members. A total of \$172,000 was donated by team members and given to their chosen organisations.

OVER \$64,000

WISHING TREES AND SANTA PHOTOS:

These programs are part of our store's Christmas activities and aim to raise funds for local rescue organisations. Rescue groups receive these donations directly from PETstock Assist. In 2018/19 this resulted in over \$64,000 being donated directly to rescue groups.

OVER \$40,000

NATIONAL PET ADOPTION DAY: Each rescue organisation that agrees to participate in PETstock Assist's National Pet Adoption Day receives a donation for their time. In 2018/19 this resulted in over \$40,000 being donated directly to rescue groups.

PETRESCUE CALENDAR: In 2018/19 PETstock and PetRescue created and sold their last ever fundraising calendar. Funds equating to \$62,000 were provided to PetRescue to assist with the creation and ongoing maintenance of their 14 programs, and website that supports rescue organisations across Australia.
